Owing to the Covid-19 pandemic, all activities got to a standstill everywhere. So, this year the medals are given aways to Prof. PARK Raju, WET Center, and Prof. M Jagapathi Raju, the Principal, SRKREC, for their research projects in the presence of Dr. D R Prasad Raju, former Scientist, DST, Govt. of India, when he visited the campus on 24th Aug. 2022 and reflected on various research projects and funding agencies.





Global Research Interactions: SPRING project

Research and innovative ideas are one the most important part of anyacademic institution. It allows one revitalize the present technology and also creates a hunger for innovations. The faculty and the students of SRKREC are invariably committed to bringing about constructive and innovative collaborations, which helps further the society as well as the institution.



Dr. PARK Raju, the Principal Investigator (SRKREC) in the DBT-EU Funded Consortium Project titled SPRING, was invited by the organizing committee to make a workshop at the IWA (International Water Association) Water Safety Conference 2022 held from 22nd to 24th June 2022 at Narvik, Norway. Prof. Raju played drone footage relating to the SPRING project to show the deterioration of water quality from the point of origin at Settipeta to tail-end.

He also presented the work undertaken in SPRING project Work Packages lead by SRKREC. The presentation was well received, and European researchers inquired about the public health administration in the region and the status of wastewater treatment.



Prof. Raju attended the SPRING Consortium partner meeting on the same day, i.e., 23rd June 2022. The UiT agreed to extend the MoU between SRKR and UiT, looking forward to more fruitful collaborations in the near future. Prof. Bjorn Reidar Sorenson of UiT and Dr. PARK Raju, SRKREC, signed the MoU for another five years in the presence of the SPRING consortium. In this context, all the consortium partners are invited to visit Bhimavaram, India, in October 2022, after the review meeting in Delhi. It is envisaged that the prototype navigation system and the sensor payload will be shipped from Portugal to Bhimavaram by October. Field Demonstrations and trials are expected to take place around that time. Prof. Raju started planning the event to involve all stakeholders and make the project achievements widely known in the region. Prof. Raju also visited Salangfisk AS, a Norwegian Company, famous for high-tech Salmon Fish farming.and is based on high technology water recirculation systems supplied by Veolia.

Mr. Nandyala Siva Kishan, Assistant. Professor, pursues doctoral degree as a part of the **SPRING** consortium project under UiT Norway. He made a presentation of his poster research work at the International Water Association Water Safety Conference-2022 held at the UiT Narvik campus from 22nd June to 24th June 2022. He also interacted with the SPRING



project partners and discussed the next project deliverables and pending tasks. He will play a key role in arranging the October 2022 meeting in SRKREC.








TECHFLEET 2K22








VINAYAKA CHAVITHI


